Meeting called to order at 6:00 pm by Chair Hoffman.

### Director Klempp called the role.

Hembree, Sulfaro, Clark. Winglemire absent Motion by Delaney to excuse. Cucksey supports. Motion carried by all ayes and no nays

### **APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES:**

Motion by Herrick and supported by Cucksey. Motion carried by a voice vote of all ayes.

### AGENDA APPROVAL:

Motion by Herrick to approve agenda Second by Cucksey. Motion carried by a voice vote of ayes and no nays.

### **FINANCIAL REPORT:**

Motion by Stouffer support by Cucksey Passed all ayes and no nays

### **PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA:**

John Lauve: Don't know what you spent money on. The room acoustics are bad. Tacky things in town- H overgrown in park, trees all have xs on them. Shouldn't cut down trees and replace with baby trees.

**Delaney:** Excuse me, President Hoffman. Point of order; these items are not on the agenda.

**Hoffman:** It's either now or later. So go ahead. **Lauve:** Ha. Thank you. Too bad on that one. The clock is not right, not sure if its been fixed. Hotel is the big one. I've saved the Village

thousands of dollars fixing up old buildings. Point is we have to do something about the Hotel. They shouldn't be holding up things like they did me with the Hotel.

Lauve: Spent money on banners. Says Holly Michigan-didn't know we were in Michigan.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

### 1. Held Public Act 57 Informational meeting

Presented about the accomplishments and goals of each of the four Main Street Committees.

Motion made by Stouffer to approve the DDA Committees work plans as purposed, Second by Cucksey. Vote all ayes no nays.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

Klempp: How this works is someone can nominate someone else to be the elected positions which are Chair, Vice chair and secretary. Right now the positions are held by Chair:Mr. Hoffman, Vice by Ms. Stouffer and Secretary by Ms. Herrick. Once they accept that we can vote on them. We can keep them the same orchange them however the board would like to proceed.

**Delaney:** I would like to nominate Ms. Stouffer for Chair.

**Herrick:** I actually like how it is now. I like the job Bob is doing as chair.

**Stouffer:** Do we have any positions that are expiring?

**Klempp:** Yes. Both Mr. Hoffman and Dr. Sulfaro.

Hoffman: Ok. So Ryan's motion died for lack of support.

**Stouffer:** I'd like to make a motion to wait until we know who will be on the board.

Hoffman: Are they planning to replace us.

Stouffer: I don't know or have any insight on that.

**Delaney:** We have two possibilities for new board members joining us. Of course that will be up to Council tomorrow night.

Hoffman: Who are the nominations? Delaney: Jerome Raska and Dave Elliot

Hoffman: You make the nominations, correct?

**Delaney:** Correct

**Hoffman:** So, if you made those nominations don't you think you should have picked the phone up to let us know? You say it is up in the air still?

**Delaney:** Yes because it is up to council to vote on it.

**Hoffman:** I'm surprised you didn't call myself or Dr. Sulfaro

Delaney: Would it have made a difference?

**Hoffman:** That's not the point. Are we not doing a good job? What's the reasoning?

**Delaney:** Longevity was a part of the consideration. I think it's healthy to include as many qualified people as possible and both Mr. Raska and Elliot had showed interest by turning in a participation form. So, I gave them their due consideration.

Hoffman: If you would have called, one of us may have said that was ok and the other myself would say I would want to continue because I have been invested in Holly for many years and to check if we would want to continue on. I'm surprised because I heard the rumors, but I

thought. No Ryan would have called me about it. Did you hold interviews? You were supposed to last time but you didn't.

**Delaney:** Well, lets not get the facts twisted Mr. President. A vetting process was done in both cases, the last time this issue was raised with the President nominating for this board and in this case. So, that can not be a complaint.

**Hoffman:** It was a complaint then and it is now. **Delaney:** Yes but there has to be fact for that complaint in order for someone to take it seriously.

Hoffman: So, is there a process open for this where people can apply and then a vetting process?

**Delaney:** There is always an open process and always a vetting process

**Hoffman:** How does someone know?

**Delaney:** It is common knowledge that if someone desires to be on a board or commission there is a citizen participation form; I believe on the Village website?

Walker: I believe so, I'm not a 100% on that but it is in the office and we do get several inquiries about it.

Delaney: Right.

**Hoffman:** Ok. Thank you. There has been a motion to postpone the election of officers. Is there a second?

Cucksey: Support

Hoffman: Lets have a role call

Klempp: Herrick-yes, Stouffer- yes, Hoffman-

No Delaney- Yes Cucksey- Yes

Hoffman: Have you ever considered that since you are a lame duck president that you would push this down the road?

**Delaney:** No. Because we handle the appointments as they expire.

Hoffman: Well sometimes we do that.

**Delaney:** Well also a lame duck president is the president non the less and I repeat that my nominations are subject to approval of the entire council. So, this is made not just by the president but by the whole council.

**Klempp:** Wanted to say that along with my written report that I will not be at the next meeting, Mr. Walker will lead the meeting. We will be on vacation for our 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary.

### **VILLAGE MANAGER REPORT:**

Walker: Just one, the Grange Hall intersection will be started with new building, new turn lane and new signals. And new dispensary will be started soon.

Stouffer: Will they wait until Muggs and Bopps is back running, or will we have two out of commission at the same time?

Walker: They didn't say that but I think they will wait because of economics- right now they have all the business. But I think the Marathon is going to stay open until new building is built with just small time of being closed while they do the parking lot.

### **PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Marlo Davidson: Not enthusiastic with what just took place. The DDA started in 1984 and I have to say thank you for all you do. You do wonderful things.

John Lauve: I don't understand why the names for replacements are not on the agenda, that is very unprofessional. Also, I own the mill and I've never been contacted by anybody about this. I guess because I don't own a business, I don't know but it's not appropriate. I don't know why you are not talking about the Hotel that is a problem for the community. We don't want to talk about that. We are not moving in the right direction. I've never been thanked for anything I have done in town.
